A message from the Eco-Church group: Bees and other pollinators are increasingly under threat from human activities. Pollination is a fundamental process for the survival of our ecosystems. Nearly 90% of the world's wild flowering plant species depend on animal pollination, along with more than 75% of the world's food crops. Not only do pollinators contribute directly to food security, but they are key to conserving biodiversity. To raise awareness of the importance of pollinators, the UN designated 20th May as **World Bee Day**. We all depend on pollinators. And the Eco Church Garden has over 30 different varieties of plants to attract pollinators.
