It is a joyful celebration of the gift of the Eucharist: our shared life with Christ and with each other as we receive Our Lord's very life and abundant saving grace in the Sacrament.

The Jack Cornwell VC Memorial Parade and Service will take place at **St Mary Magdalene's TODAY at 12.30pm**. All are welcome to this service at which we remember 16 year-old John ('Jack') Travers Cornwell of Alverstone Road, East Ham, killed in action at the Battle of Jutland on 2 June 1916 and posthumously awarded the Victoria Cross for his conspicuous act of bravery.
