FROM THE TEAM RECTOR

This week we received the sad news of the death of Bishop Stephen Lowe, first Team Rector of East Ham Team Parish. He died on Friday 26 June 'peacefully but not unexpectedly'. His funeral is likely to be at the end of July at Chester Cathedral. Canon Ann will share some reflections in next week's newsletter.

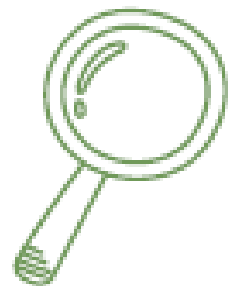
