Thank you to everyone who made last week's Patronal Festival of St Mary Magdalene such a success. It was an important time to welcome visitors and those unfamiliar with the church.

St Mary's was packed for the E6 Chamber Choir concert, the audience including a great number of families with young children, many of whom had not been into the church before. The concert raised over £500 split between the church and NEWway Project. NEWway, based nearby in Flanders Fields, run the nightshelter that we host at St Mary's Hall in the winter as well as a whole host of services for homeless people.

On the Saturday we welcomed visitors from near and far, including an art historian, a family historian, a bell ringer and many others. Our next open day is Open House festival on 19 September. There was a good turnout for the Family Nature Club and the day concluded with a prayer walk in the nature reserve, exploring areas some of us had never been to before. Watch out for more Family Nature Club events to come.

And we finished with a glorious festival eucharist with our guest preacher Br Samuel SSF, followed by lunch organised by our accomplished refreshments team. It was very heartening to see folk from all our churches, along with many visitors and newcomers. It was also bittersweet to say goodbye to Chris our organist and choirmaster who will be much missed.

Now we can look forward to celebrating St Bart's patronal on Sunday 6th September!
