This week some of us joined Rev Mutuota for the 'in the round' discussion, where we heard about the problems of unpredictable rains, flooding and drought, and the solutions being developed for his region. The reality of the climate crisis is here and now, not sometime in the future, and it is happening to people just like us, all around the world.
