A message from the Eco Church group - COP30 is the annual United Nations Conference on Climate Change. This year it is taking place in Belem in the Amazon Rainforest between 10th and 21st November. It will bring together world leaders, scientists, and others to discuss priority actions to tackle climate change. COP30 will focus on the efforts needed to limit the global temperature increase to 1.5°C and the financial commitments needed. In July the International Court of Justice made a ruling that places human rights at the heart of climate action. Will the leaders, political and financial, refocus their 'collective efforts on maintaining a liveable world for the flora and fauna, as well as the many and diverse people that inhabit it'?
