NEWdawn winter night shelter Our parish is teaming up with Bonny Downs Baptist church who will be hosting NEWdawn winter night shelter one night a week at St Mary's Hall starting 2nd January 2026. NEWdawn is Newham's church-led winter night shelter that operates during the coldest months of the year, safely giving shelter to up to 15 guests a night. NEWdawn is a partnership where professional staff teams manage referrals, organise the overall running of shelter and undertake case work with the guests, and churches in Newham surround guests with safety and opportunity from within a compassionate community.
